LSU Insurance Coverage

LSU Insurance Coverage

Benefits	Limits
Emergency Medical	\$10,000
Medical Expense (Accident or Sickness)	\$250,000 (\$1,000 for dental emergencies)
Emergency Medical Evacuation	100% (\$250,000 from Antarctica, Greenland)
Security Evacuation	\$100,000
Repatriation of Remains	100% (\$250,000 from Antarctica, Greenland)
Emergency Reunion	\$5,000 up to \$500 a day for 10 days.
Trip Cancellation, Delay, or Interruption	\$2,500
Accidental Death & Dismemberment	\$100,000 (Employees) \$25,000 (Students and Guest)

Some Exclusions and Limitations

Routine physicals and routine care of any kind (including dental)

Cosmetic surgery, except for reconstructive surgery needed as result of injury

Services, supplies, or treatments (including Hospital confinement) not recommended, approved, and certified as medically necessary and reasonable by a Doctor, or expenses which are non-medical

Treatment or service provided by a private-duty nurse

Treatment by any Immediate Family Member or immediate member of insured's household

Any expenses paid or payable by any other valid and collectible group insurance plan, workers' compensation plan, or other similar plan

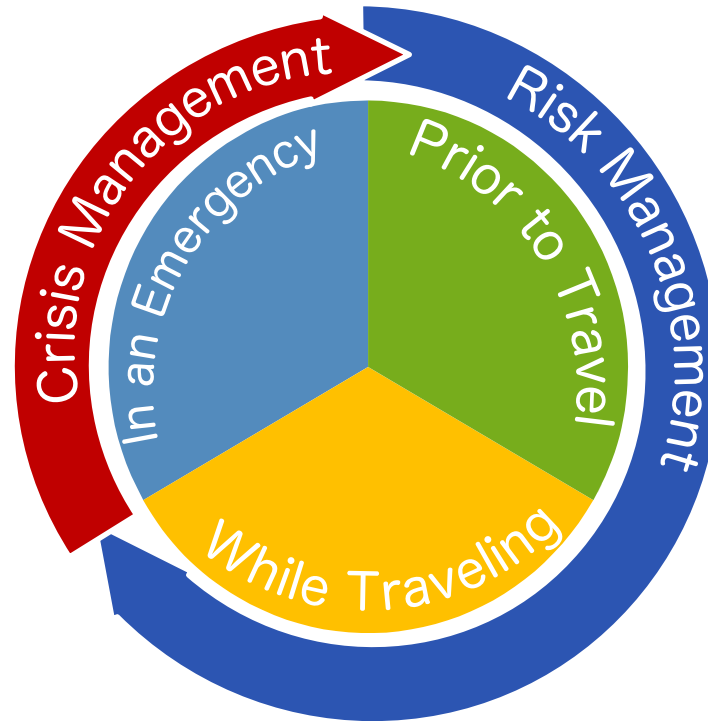
Any injury or sickness for which benefits are paid or payable under occupational disease law act or similar legislation

Eye refractions or examinations for the purpose of prescribing corrective lenses, eyeglasses, contact lenses, and hearing aids

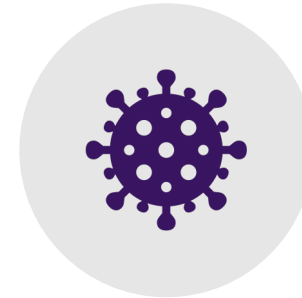
