Policies for Emergencies Louisiana State University School of Kinesiology (SOK) Fall 2013

What to do in case of a health emergency:

- Have cellphone on your person as all times, including class and meetings.
- KIN office should be alerted if campus police are called.
- Send a student to greet campus police and direct to location
 - 1. Call LSU Police at 578-3231 or 8-3231 (from campus phone).
 - 2. Give the communications officer the following information:
 - a. who you are and your location
 - b. the nature of the emergency
 - c. type of injury or illness
 - d. status of the victim
 - e. breathing, bleeding, consciousness, etc.
 - f. any known medical condition(s) of the victim
 - g. any circumstances that may help or impede response personnel
 - h. what phone number you can be contacted at
 - 3. DO NOT move the victim

4. DO NOT give medical care unless you are trained to do so. Provide first aid if you are qualified to do so.

- 5. Stay with the victim until help arrives.
- 6. Remain calm and follow directions given by emergency personnel.

What to do in the event of a campus wide emergency:

- Sign-up for emergency text alerts through your PAWS account.
- Have cellphone on your person as all times, including class and meetings.
- Follow any evacuation procedures immediately, if instructed.
- Shelter in place, lock and block doors, if instructed.
- In the event of an emergency you witness (hostile intruder, suspicious object, etc.): 1. Call LSU Police at 578-3231.
 - 2. Give the communications officer the following information:
 - a. who you are and your location
 - b. the nature of the emergency
 - 3. Remain calm and follow directions given by emergency personnel.
