Rene R. Joyce serves as a director of Targa Resources Corporation, a mid-stream company, which he founded.

He served as Targa Resources' executive chairman of the board (2012-2014) and as its chief executive officer (2005-2011). He also served as a member of the supervisory directors of Core Laboratories N.V. (2000—2013) and the board of directors of Apache Corporation (2017-2021).

In addition to his leadership roles with Targa Resources, several of its subsidiaries, Apache and Core Labs, Mr. Joyce previously served as president of on-shore pipeline operations of Coral Energy, LLC, a subsidiary of Shell Oil Company, and as president of energy services of Coral Energy Holding, LP, also a subsidiary of Shell, and the gas and power marketing joint venture between Shell and Tejas Gas Corporation, a natural gas pipeline company.

Prior to Shell's acquisition of Tejas in 1998, he served as president of various operating subsidiaries of Tejas. Mr. Joyce holds a Bachelor of Science degree in mechanical engineering from Louisiana State University and a law degree from Loyola University. He is married to Mrs. Kay P. Joyce.
