Please review information about this status: “In rare circumstances, degree programs may request that the Graduate School place students who cannot identify a major professor or form a graduate committee on a status called ‘No Clear Path to Degree Completion.’ This may also occur following the resignation of a major professor and/or committee members due to concerns about the student’s professional conduct or ability to engage effectively with faculty advisors. This status is distinct from academic standing, which is based on academic progress.

After being placed on this status, students will be given until the end of the next full semester (fall or spring) to identify a major professor or form a committee. During that time, the program is expected to make reasonable efforts to work collaboratively with the student to resolve the situation, and these efforts must be reported to the Graduate School; however, the responsibility for finding a major professor and forming a committee remains with the student. If the issue is not resolved by the end of that semester, the program may request that the student be dismissed from the degree program.”
