Dear Phi Gamma Delta,

Based on the information presented and discussed, the Beta Rho chapter of Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity accepts responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically 10.2.W Violating a Rule of the University, which was PS-78 (Alcohol Policy). As a result, your chapter has submitted the Chapter Enhancement Plan to meet the requirements of the partnership process with Greek Life and Student Advocacy & Accountability:

LETTER OF REPRIMAND - EFFECTIVE through December 31, 2018

As a result of the incident that occurred on October 31, 2017, where Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity members and guests gathered at the Phi Gamma Delta house before an off-campus event and consumed alcohol in private rooms, the following will occur:

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the [online reporting form](#).

Organization Letter of Reprimand

This accountability status will be effective March 26, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

1) A new implementation that has been added into the housing agreement that members, if found with alcohol in their respective rooms and under the age of 21, will be placed on social probation pending the outcome of a Judiciary Board hearing. If found in violation of this rule a second time the member will lose privileges to all FIJI events and face further sanctions with Housing Corporation and the chapter as a whole. (see copy of housing agreement).

2) The Risk Management committee has been revamped in order to include members currently living in the house as well as those outside to effectively stop such events from reoccurring. The committee this spring is comprised of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The bylaws will reflect the number of in house and outside of house members and how they will be chosen. [REDACTED] is the chairman of this committee and meets biweekly the first meeting is scheduled for next Sunday following our chapter meeting. Reports of the committee are sent to the president ([REDACTED]). This committee is placed as standing committee in the Bylaws.

3) The chapter will have a member of the Greek Life staff review PS 78 with the chapter by April 15,

2019. 90% of the members must be in attendance. Documentation due to SAA by April 16, 2018.

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability within the Office of the Dean of Students. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
